RESUMPTION OF NORMAL WORK ARRANGEMENTS: LIVING WITH COVID-19


Reference is made to Cabinet Office Circular Minute of 2021 dated 7th January, 2021 on work arrangements aimed at curbing the spread of COVID-19.

It has been observed that there has been a reduction in the COVID-19 positivity rate in the country in the recent past. In this regard, Government has decided that the working arrangements be normalised with immediate effect, to be reviewed after twenty-one (21) days.

However, with the country moving towards the cold season, Cabinet Office will continue to monitor the situation and will take appropriate action in the event that the country records an increase in the COVID-19 positivity rate. Addressees are, therefore, directed to resume normal work schedules with strict adherence to Public Health guidelines and to increase the utilisation of electronic platforms to ensure smooth service delivery and effective communication.

In addition, all employees in the Public Service are urged to continue to adhere to the COVID-19 preventive interventions through the following: masking up, practicing hand hygiene, physical distancing, avoiding crowding and reporting to health authorities upon development of signs and symptoms of COVID-19.

Addressees are advised to urgently bring the contents of the Circular Minute to the attention of all employees under their supervision.
